Mission



Wishes & More® enhances the life of a child fighting a terminal or life-threatening condition by providing extraordinary experiences... and more.

Purpose

The purpose of **Wishes & More** is to grant the wish of a child between birth and nineteen who has a terminal or lifethreatening condition which will require ongoing treatment and to provide a **Scholarship of Hope**® to be used for higher education: or to give a memorial to the family in the event the child does not survive to have his/her wish fulfilled.



Population Served



Wishes & More serves all children who apply prior to their 19th birthday and have a physician's qualifying statement attesting to the child's lifethreatening condition requiring ongoing treatment. Services are provided to children living in Minnesota; or who live in the border states of North Dakota, South Dakota, Iowa, and Wisconsin; or are receiving ongoing treatment in a Minnesota medical facility.
